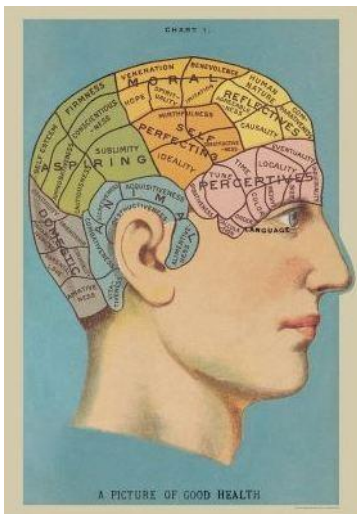


# Join us for an evening of Phrenology and Fun at the Upton House on Saturday, November 10, 2018

Following happy hour at 6pm, a generous autumn dinner based on the season's bounty will be served in the dining room featuring the famous chicken ball from the Passion Bakery in Latrobe, PA.

Phrenology became very popular in the early years of the 19<sup>th</sup> c. when it was accepted as a scientific way of determining personality by examining cranial bumps. Scholarly journals were written and schools founded to teach the discipline. Phrenology gradually was discredited as "pseudo-science" and faded away to be replaced by modern psychology.

After dinner, Nelson Sizer, famous 19<sup>th</sup> century Phrenologist will reveal personality traits and mental abilities of several guests by analyzing their craniums. During his long career, Sizer examined more than 300,000 heads. Sizer will be portrayed by special guest Tom Kelleher from Old Sturbridge Village in Massachusetts. Kelleher is the Historian and Curator of Mechanical Arts and has worked at OSV for more than 30 years.
